Directions for Use

It is important to follow your aesthetic professional's guidelines for use.

Chiroxy cream's oxygenating, soothing, moisturising and anti-oxidant properties make it suitable for helping recovering skin. Apply to intact skin as often as required to soothe and calm the skin, keep applying until the skin feels and appears recovered.

The avoidance of sun exposure and the use of a high level and broad spectrum UVB & UVA sun protector is normally advised before and after a cosmetic procedure. Ask your Aesthetic professional about **Heliocare** advanced UV protection products.

Pre-procedure: Your practitioner may decide that your skin, due to previous damage or stress, requires additional help prior to your cosmetic procedure. Twice daily application of **Chiroxy** cream for a period of 4 weeks has been shown to significantly increase the O₂ content of the skin area it is applied to. Apply twice daily to clean skin in the area concerned.

Chiroxy cream has a 6 month shelf life once opened. Use before expiry date.
