# Melaclear - Sunscreen SPF 50+



Over exposure to the sun can lead to a range of skin problems, the most serious of which is skin cancer.

UV radiation penetrates the earth's atmosphere in two wavelengths UVA and UVB.

UVA radiation penetrates deeper in the skin than UVB and can damage collagen and elastin leading to sun-induced skin ageing and areas of hyperpigmentation. UVA protection in a sunscreen helps defend the skin against photo ageing and potentially skin cancer also.

UVB radiation causes sunburn. Sunscreens are labeled with an 'SPF'. This stands for 'sun protection factor' which is the amount of protection against sunburn a sunscreen will provide.

#### **Directions for use**

Before sun exposure (approx 20 minutes) apply generous amounts of sunscreen over the entire face and neck. Ensure sunscreen is rubbed in well. Re-apply frequently (approx every 2 hours) and particularly after swimming. Avoid exposure during maximum sunshine hours.

When used in conjunction with **MelaClear serum**, apply serum first and allow to absorb. Once serum is absorbed apply **MelaClear Sunscreen SPF 50+**.

### **Directions for use**

**MelaClear** depigmenting care serum should be applied twice daily to the area of hyperpigmentation.

Disperse a drop of serum onto your finger and gently massage into the required area and allow to absorb. Continue to apply in the same manner to all areas that require treatment.
